Explanatory Note

(This note is not part of the amendments but is intended to be merely clarificatory.)

Rule 31 of the Estate Duty Rules, 1953, refers to the assignment of existing insurance policies to the Government for the purpose of paying Estate Duty. Consequent to the coming into being of the Life Insurance Corporation of India, the Life insurance business of all the Insurance Companies has been taken over by the Corporation itself. Hence the name of the Corporation has been used in the Rules as all future policies will be issued by it.
